**INSTRUCTION TO TENDERERS  
AND**

**GENERAL DIRECTION AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT**

**1. DEFINITION AND INTERPRETATION:**

The following words and expression shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them except where the context otherwise requires:

- (a) Employer means the Managing Director, IDCOL Ferro Chrome & Alloys Ltd, A Wholly Owned Subsidiary of Industrial Development Corporation of Orissa Ltd.
- (b) Management means, Managing Director, IDCOL Ferro Chrome & Alloys Ltd. or his authorized representative.
- (c) Corporation means, IDCOL Ferro Chrome & Alloys Ltd., A Wholly Owned Subsidiary of Industrial Development Corporation of Orissa Ltd.
- (d) **TCM means, Talangi Chromite Mine of M/s IDCOL located at Talangi, Po. Kansa, Via- Kalaringata, PS-Kaliapani, Dist-JAJPUR, Pin-755028**
- (e) Authorized representative shall mean the Officers / Supervisors in direct charge of the work which shall be communicated to the Contractor in course of execution of the work from time to time by the management.
- (f) The tender shall mean the tender submitted by the tenderer for acceptance by Employer. The tender may also be called the bid and tenderer as bidder.
- (g) Contractor shall mean the person, firm or company who enters into contract with the IDCOL Ferro Chrome & Alloys Ltd., Jajpur Road and shall include their executors, administrators, successors and permitted assignees.
- (h) Contract shall mean and include the Contract Agreement, Letter of Intent, work order, the Tender document duly filled in and signed by the tenderer and the tender papers comprising important information, information sheet, instructions to tenderers and General Directions and Conditions of Contract, Special Terms and Conditions, Scope of Work, Schedule to tender.
- (i) Month means, English Calendar month.
- (j) Words incorporating the singular only also include the plural and vice versa where the context requires.

## 2. TENDER BY OTHER THAN INDIVIDUAL:

When the tender is not submitted in the name of an individual, the contractor shall disclose the nature, constitution and registration of the tendering firm and shall be signed by a person or persons duly authorizing him by means of a legally valid document (or a duly certified copy of the same) which shall be attached with the tender. For illustration in the event of a tender being submitted by a partnership firm, it must be signed separately by each member thereof or in the event of the absence of any partner. It must be signed on his behalf by a person holding a power of attorney, which is to be produced with the tender and it must disclose that the firm is duly registered under Indian Partnership Act.

## 3. TENDERS LIABLE FOR REJECTION:

The following tenders will be liable for summarily rejection.

- (k) Tenders submitted by contractors who resort to canvassing.
- (ii) Tenders, which do not fulfill all or any of the conditions laid down in the tender documents or are incomplete in any respect.
- (iii) Tenders which contain uncalled for remarks or any alternative / additional conditions.
- (iv) Any person / firm / company who had been previously awarded any work have failed to execute the work fully or partially to the satisfaction of the management for any reasons whatsoever or have past records of unruly misbehavior inside or outside the plant premises pertaining to his work or otherwise shall not be eligible for submission of this tender. If it is received by mistake or oversight the same would be liable for rejection without assigning any reason thereof.

## 4. COMPLETIONS AND SIGNING OF THE TENDER:

The tenderers are to return the tender document (comprising of 'Techno-commercial Bid', 'Price Bid' and rest part of the Tender document such as cover page, Tender call notice, documents for General Direction and conditions of contract, documents for special terms and conditions and document for safety appliances) in original and duly completed. The tender is likely to be ignored if complete information is not given there in or if the particulars asked in the 'Techno-commercial Bid' and 'Price Bid' are not duly filled in. The tenderer shall have to sign all pages of tender paper, as a token of acceptance of the terms and conditions stipulated in the tender.

## 5. SUBMISSION OF TENDER PAPER:

This set of tender document has, among others, a Techno-commercial Bid format and another Price Bid format. The technical and price bid should be **put in separate sealed covers** after detaching the same from the Tender document and be marked with the tender **reference number, name of the work and the name of the tenderer. Each should also be identified by writing on the sealed envelope as "Techno-commercial Bid" or "Price Bid", as the case may be. Both the sealed covers should be put in a separate bigger size sealed cover along with rest part of the tender document** such as cover page, index, Tender call notice, Important information documents for Instruction to Tenderers and General and conditions of contract, documents for special terms and conditions and other documents of tender which should be tagged or stapled.

The bigger envelope should be superscribed with tender reference number, name of the work and name of the tenderer in bold letters and shall be sent to the Managing Director, IDCOL Ferro Chrome & Alloys Ltd., P.O - Ferrochrome Project, Dist- Jajpur-755 020 by Regd. Post / Courier / Speed Post only so as to reach him by specified date and time as mentioned in “**Important Information**” and which shall be opened at the time, date & place as mentioned therein. The contractor or their authorized representatives may witness the opening of the tender. Tenders sent by any other mode other than as mentioned above will not be taken into consideration.

The management shall not be held responsible for any delay in submission of the tender. Tender received after the due date and time shall not be taken into consideration.

- a) The “Techno-commercial bid” shall contain Earnest Money in Shape of D/D or Banker’s Cheque and all other relevant document as stated above including unpriced bid duly signed.
- b) The documents for “Price Bid” shall contain the Price Bid format only filled in with quoted rates. The bidders shall quote their rates both in figures as well as in words without erasing, cuttings and over writing. The prices quoted should be legible and have no ambiguity. In case of variation between prices quoted in words and figures, those quoted in words shall be final and binding.

#### **6. OPENING OF TENDER:**

The ‘Techno-commercial Bid’ shall be opened first. The format for giving details of the contractors shall be checked with verification of certificates asked for and thereafter “Eligibility Criteria” shall be checked. The bid found to have not fulfilled the conditions laid therein shall be rejected. The “Price Bid” shall be opened thereafter in those cases where Techno-commercial Bids have been found to be acceptable.

Due to any eventuality, if the tender opening is not completed on the scheduled date, then the same shall be continued in the next working day.

7. In the event of quoting equal L<sub>1</sub> price by more than one tenderer, the successful tenderer for the job shall be decided by ‘Lucky Draw’ system to be conducted by the tender committee. The ‘Lucky Draw’ may be witnessed by the L<sub>1</sub> tenderers on being duly intimated regarding date, time & venue mentioned therein. Method of ‘Lucky Draw’ system adopted by the management for selecting the successful bidder is final and binding for all purposes and no complain in this regard will be entertained.

#### **8.. VALIDITY OF TENDER:**

The tender shall remain valid for a period of 60 days from the date of opening. During the period of validity, if a tenderer wants to withdraw from the bidding, their EMD shall be forfeited.

#### **9. MANAGEMENT WILL NOT ASSIGN ANY REASON FOR REJECTION OF TENDER:**

The acceptance of tender will rest with the Managing Director, IDCOL Ferro Chrome & Alloys Ltd., Jajpur Road who does not bind himself to accept the lowest tender if the same is found unworkable and reserves himself the right:

- (i) To reject any or all tender or
- (ii) To split up the work amongst and award a part thereof only to the tenderer without assigning any reason or giving any explanation thereof.

## 10. ACCEPTANCE OF TENDER:

Acceptance of the tender will be intimated to the successful contractor through a **Letter of Intent**. The contractor is required to submit the acceptance of LOI within 7 (seven) days from the date of receipt of LOI failing which it will be presumed the contractor is not interested to accept the order. On receipt of acceptance copy of LOI, Work Order shall be issued. In the event of non delivery of LOI either for any Postal/Courier service delay or absence of addressee at their place, management will not be held responsible for non delivery of the same. In such case EMD shall be forfeited..

## 11. FAILURES AND TERMINATION:

Should the contractor any time fail to execute the work in accordance with the requirement specified in the tender, the employer will be at liberty to adopt any or several of the following.

- (a) To rescind the contract for which rescission notice in writing to the contractor under the hand of the management shall be conclusive evidence in which case the EMD of the contractor with IFCAL shall stand forfeited.
- (b) The employer shall have right to recover from the contractor all consequential losses due to contractor's failure to execute the contract and any amount by which the cost of completing the work by any other agency shall exceed the value of the contract and the employer shall have lien on contractor's bills / properties and EMD for those amounts of the employer
- (c) To carry out the works or part thereof by the employment of required labour, the costs of which shall include all expenses including supervision and incidental charges and debit the contractor with such costs, the amount of which as certified by the management shall be final and binding upon the contractor, and to credit the contractor with the value of the works done as if the works had been carried out by the contractor under the terms of the contract and the certificate of management in respect of the amount to be credited to the contractor shall be final and binding upon the contractor.
- (d) To measure up the work executed by the contractor and to get the remaining work completed by another contractor at the risk and expense of the contractor in all respects in which case any expenses that may be incurred in excess of the sum which would have been paid to the contractor if works had been carried out by him under the terms of the contract, the amount of which excess as certified by the management shall be final and binding upon the contractor shall be borne and paid by the contractor and may be deducted from any amount due to him by IDCOL Ferro Chrome & Alloys Ltd. under the contract or other wise or from his Security deposit.

Besides the above, during execution of the contract job job and in case of identification of any fraudulent documents submitted by the tenderer along with the tender by any means/at any circumstances/at any period of the contract, the contract then shall be terminated with the rescission notice to the contractor at his own cost and risk and accordingly the security deposit thereof shall be forfeited without any responsibility and obligation in whatsoever manner.

## 12. FORCE MAJEURE

### CONDITIONS FOR FORCE MAJEURES

In the event of either party being rendered unable by Force majeure to perform any obligations required to be performed by them under the CONTRACT the relative obligation of the party affected by such Force Majeure shall upon notification to the other party be suspended for the period during which Force Majeure shall upon notification to the other party be suspended for the period during which force majeure even lasts. The cost and loss sustained by either party shall be born by respective parties.

The term "Force Majeure" as employed herein shall mean acts of God, Earthquake, War (declared or undeclared), revolts, riots, fires, floods, rebellions, explosions, hurricane, sabotage, civil commotion's and acts and regulations of the two parties, namely the OWNER and the CONTRACTOR. Upon the occurrence of such causes and upon its terminations, the contractor alleging that it has been rendered unable as aforesaid thereby shall notify the IFCAL/TCM in writing immediately but not later, than 24 Hrs. of the alleged is beginning and ending thereof, giving full particulars and satisfactory evidence in support of his claim. Time for performance of the relative obligation suspended by the force Majeure shall then standard by the period for which cause lasts. If works to be executed by the contractor are suspended by the Force majeure conditions lasting for more than two months the owner shall have the option to terminate the contract.

### 13. LEGAL DISPUTE AND ARBITRATION:

- (i) All disputes, differences, controversies or claims arising out of or relating to construction, meaning and operation or effect of this contract or breach or termination or invalidity thereof, if not resolved by mutual discussion, either party may give to other party notice in writing of existence of such dispute, question or difference and the matter shall be referred to Chairman, IFCAL as the " Sole Arbitrator " and whose decision and award made thereof shall be final and binding on the parties.
- (ii) The venue of Arbitration will be at Bhubaneswar.
- (iii) The parties here to mutually agreed that notwithstanding the place of execution, the contract shall be taken to have been entered into by the parties at Jajpur Road, (Odisha) and for the purpose of any legal dispute if any in the court of law, the jurisdiction shall be limited to any courts under the jurisdiction of Hon'ble High Court of Odisha.

### 14. SAFETY:

- i) Health and safety being the prime responsibility of the contractor for the workmen employed by him. He must provide all safety appliances to his workmen during the work.
- ii) The contractor must ensure that none of his workmen should enter the T.C.Mines premises without prescribed safety appliances. In case, any deviation observed the concerned workman shall be provided with prescribed safety appliances by IFCAL/TCM and the cost of which shall be recovered from the concerned contractor's bills, without taking any consent from the contractor or the workmen shall be refused for entry to T.C.Mines at the entire discretion of IFCAL/TCM depending upon importance of the job.
- iii) **The contractor must follow the COVID-19 guidelines of Central/State Govt. during the execution of the job.**
- iv) **If personal injury is caused for a workman by an accident arising out of and in the course of employment or the accident which is resulted either in death of the workman or his total or partial disablement arising out of and in course of employment, the contractor shall be liable for payment of compensation under the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1923. IFCAL/TCM shall not be responsible to make payment of compensation under such AMC and the compensation amount shall be borne by the contractor.**

## **SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT**

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### **1. NATURE AND DESCRIPTION OF JOB:**

The contractor has to execute the work of “**OVERHAULING, MAINTANANCE, INSTALLATION, TESTING & COMMISSIONING OF 33/0.4KV, 250 KVA TRANSFORMER AND REDUCTION OF CONTRACT DEMAND FROM 472 KVA TO 70 KVA**” at our

**Talangi Chromite Mine of M/s IDCOL located at Talangi,Po.Kansa,Via-Kalaringata,PS-Kaliapani,Dist-JAJPUR,Pin-755028**

### **2. SCOPE OF WORK:**

i) Oil Filtration of 33/.04 KV, 250 KVA Transformer.

ii)Overhauling,maintenance,installation,testing and commissioning of 33/.4 KV,250 KVA transformer at our 33 KV switch yard after due inspection by SE cum Electrical Inspector,Angul.

iii) To obtain permission from DGMS,South Estern Zone,CMPD campus,Kanke Road,Ranchi as per regulation 43(3) or 43(4) of Central Electricity Rule.

iv) Dismantling work of 500 KVA Transformer from its foundation bed & overhead line & shifting to safe custody inside the mines.

v) Disconnection of all motor loads, switch gear from the main panel also from motor side except lighting line of entire mine area & ETP as per our required load of 70 KVA.

vi) Reduction of Contract Demand from 472 KVA to 70 KVA with signing of fresh agreement with **TPCODL**, Bhubaneswar by maintaining all statutory formalities for which IFCL/TCM will provide all the records and documents. After signing of agreement the agreement paper will be handed over to IFCL/TCM.

vii) All liasioning & inspection charges/fees required for the above statutory body will be borne by the contractor.

viii) The contractor has to prepare the drawings for above work and as per approval of drawings by IFCL/TCM electrical department, the contractor shall execute the above work strictly as per the approved drawing.

ix) Any kind of 33 KV line shut down required for the job will be arranged jointly by the contractor and IFCL/TCM, Electrical dept.

### **3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA & ENCLOSURES REQUIRED TO BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH THE TECHNICAL BID:**

i. The bidder must be a valid electrical HT license holder and empanelled CESU/NESCO/OPTCL contractor.

ii. The bidder should have at least 3 (Three) years of experience in dealing with similar project work undertaken in last three years i.e. 2017-18, 2018-19 & 2019-20 along with self attested copies of performance certificates from the respective client in respect of cost, performance, nature of work and details of work in hand along with copies of work order to be enclosed towards proof of experience..

iii. Registered Partnership deed in case of a partnership firm, Memorandum and Articles of Association in case of a Joint stock company, Proprietorship certificate duly certified by a notary in a stamp paper in case of proprietorship firm is to be enclosed.

- iv. The bidder should have the PAN issued by Income Tax Authority with Service Tax Registration No from Central Excise Dept., GST Registration Number No & ESI Registration No with proof of documents
- v. The bidder should submit a self certificate that firm is not debarred / black listed by any State Govt. or Central Govt. Organization/Department.
- vi. The bidder should submit an EMD of Rs.10000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) which should be enclosed in the technical bid in shape of DD Bankers cheque in favour of "IDCOL Ferro Chrome & Alloys Ltd"., drawn on any Nationalized Bank. Earnest money will not received in cash.

### 3. GENERAL

- (a) Special Conditions of Contract shall be read in conjunction with the General Conditions of Contract, specifications of work, drawings and any other document forming part of this contract wherever the contract so requires.
- (b) All jobs of electrical nature shall be carried out by the approved license holder electrician suitable for working in HT/LT electrical panel.
- (c) The Contractor's authorized representative (Owner/Director/Partner/Manager/Supervisor) shall personally contact Sectional in charge of the Electrical Dept. at IFCL/TCM during execution of the job.
- (d) All the rules and regulations prevailing and applicable from time to time at the execution of job as directed by IFCL/TCM will be strictly adhered to by the contractor..

### 5. **It shall be presumed that bidder have understood the quantum and type of jobs to be carried out under this contract. The jobs mentioned under contract shall be carried out as per the work procedure and as per guidelines / directions of IFCL/TCM/ELECT dept. or his authorized representative to the contractor from time to time. In general, the work performed by the contractor shall confirm to relevant standard and good engineering practice.**

- (a) Contractor has to ensure the safety of man and machine all the times. Damage of equipments due to bad workmanship /negligence will be recovered as per the decision of IFCL/TCM dept. which will be final.
- (b) The contractor shall ensure that the equipment to be attended is dismantled carefully without damaging to any part/parts etc. However, if there is any such damage before dismantling of the equipment, the same is to be shown to the Engineer who is supervising the Job.
- (c) The recovery in respect or any spare which is damaged due to negligence on the part of contractor will be done at the rates mentioned in the price catalogue of the manufacturer or any other source plus overheads also.
- (d) Carrying / striking of matches, lighters or smoking or other such acts which may cause fire hazards inside the mines is strictly prohibited.

### 6. PRICE:

The price should be quoted as per the price bid format. The detail break up should be given in the prescribed format as (i) and (ii) in the specified box.

### 7. WARRANTY:

The tenderer shall indicate the warranty for the jobs executed at site in respect of proper workmanship for a period of 2(two) months.

**8. EXTENSION OF TIME:**

If the contractor would desire an extension of time for completion of the work on the ground of his difficulties in executing the work in time, he shall apply in writing for such time extension, which the management may at their absolute discretion allow such extension of time, subject to imposition of such further conditions, as the management may consider necessary. The decision of the management in the above matter shall be final and binding on the contractor.

**9. FREIGHT & INSURANCE**

No separate transportation & transit insurance charges if any shall be paid to the contractor. The tenderer is advised accordingly to quote the price.

**10. PACKING & FORWARDING:**

All the materials required for the work should be securely packed and forwarded to the site with proper document. The cost of packing & forwarding shall be borne by the tenderer.

**11. INSPECTION:**

IFCAL/TCM reserves the right to inspect the materials at the supplier's site or work site if required.

**12. EARNEST MONEY:**

The contractor is required to deposit Earnest Money as specified in "Important information" of the tender document. The Earnest Money should be deposited in shape of Bank Draft / Banker's Cheque / pay order in favour of "IDCOL Ferro Chrome & Alloys Ltd.," drawn on any Nationalized Bank / scheduled Bank payable at Jajpur Road. Earnest Money will not be received in cash.

Tenderers without Earnest Money or with partial Earnest Money will be summarily rejected. No interest is payable on Earnest Money. Earnest money of the successful tenderer will be converted into security deposit. **Earnest Money of unsuccessful tenderes will be refunded after 30 days from the date of opening of the tender.**

**13. PAYMENT:**

i) 25 % payment of the work order value shall be released after overhauling and maintenance work of 250 KVA transformer at site.

ii) 50 % payment of the work order value shall be released after successful commissioning of 250 KVA transformer.

iii) 20 % payment of the work order value shall be released after reduction of contract demand from 472 KVA to 70 KVA and submitting the fresh signing agreement paper with TPCODL, Bhubaneswar.

iv) Balance 5 % of the work order value shall be released after two months of successful operation of 250 KVA transformer.

The tenderer should submit the bills in triplicate which will be duly verified & certified by the concerned Deptt. and will be sent to the Finance Deptt. for release of the payment. All the taxes such as Income tax or any other statutory deductions imposed during the contract period shall be deducted at source from the tenderer's bill. However, the **GST** shall be paid extra.

**14. SECURITY DEPOSIT:**
